Admissions Criteria for the Nursery

Admission to the nursery will be made by the governing body in accordance with the stated parental preferences it receives subject to the following criteria.

NB –

- (i) Roman Catholic children must produce a copy of their Baptism Certificate on application.*
- (ii) Parish – The Parish is The Parish of the Divine Mercy but the catchment area for the school is defined by St Herbert's Parish Boundaries as laid down by Salford Diocese.*

1. Catholic Looked After Children and Catholic previously Looked After Children – Full Time Places.
2. Catholic Looked After Children and Catholic previously Looked After Children – Part Time Places.
3. Catholic Children who are resident in the Divine Mercy Parish within the defined catchment area of St Herbert's school *as laid down by the Salford Diocese* – Full Time Places.
4. Catholic Children who are resident in the Divine Mercy Parish within the defined catchment area of St Herbert's school *as laid down by the Salford Diocese* – Part Time Places.
5. Catholic children who are resident in the Divine Mercy parish for whom St Herbert's RC Primary is the nearest Catholic school – Full Time Places.
6. Catholic children who are resident in the Divine Mercy parish for whom St Herbert's RC Primary is the nearest Catholic school – Part Time Places.
7. Other Catholic children – Full Time Places.
8. Other Catholic children – Part Time Places.
9. Other looked after and previously looked after children – Full Time Places.
10. Other looked after and previously looked after children – Part Time Places.
11. Catechumens and members of an Eastern Christian Church – Full Time Places.
12. Catechumens and members of an Eastern Christian Church – Part Time Places.
13. Children of other Christian denominations whose membership is evidenced by a minister of religion – Full Time Places.
14. Children of other Christian denominations whose membership is evidenced by a minister of religion – Part Time Places.
15. Children of other faiths whose membership is evidenced by a religious leader – Full Time Places.
16. Children of other faiths whose membership is evidenced by a religious leader – Part Time Places.
17. Any other children – Full Time Places.
18. Any other children – Part Time Places.

The attendance of a brother or sister at the school at the time of enrolment will increase the priority of an application within each category so that the application will be placed at the top of the category in which the application is made.

- ❖ **NOTES** The governing body is the admissions authority. The admissions committee is comprised of the following governors: chair of governors, parish priest, foundation governor, Headteacher, parent governor and independent clerk.
