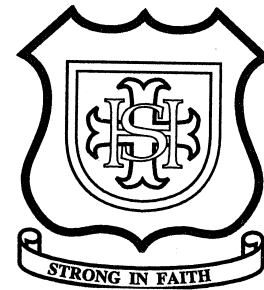

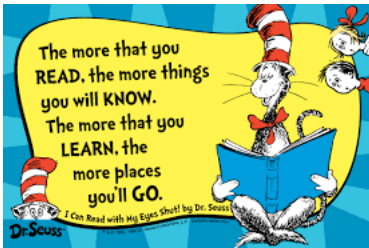
A few notices before we finish for half-term next Thursday 15th February.
