Following our governor's meeting last night, we will continue our phased approach **on Monday 22nd June with our Yr 1 pupils. As always, we will continue to monitor the public health data nationally and locally, to ensure it remains safe to open.

The school will **close to all pupils for the Summer Holidays**, on 16th July for Yr 1 and Yr 6 pupils and on 17th July for Key Worker/Vulnerable children.
